RESOLUTION NO. 20-05

RESOLUTION TO EXTEND STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Mayor of Hallam Borough (the “Borough”) declared a State of Emergency effective 8:00 am on March 16, 2020 in accordance with the Borough Code, 8 Pa.C.S. § 10A06;

WHEREAS, Section 10A06 of the Borough Code empowers the Borough to extend the state of emergency by resolution of Borough Council;

WHEREAS, Borough Council finds that there is a continued threat to public health and safety due to the spread of the COVID-19, also known as Coronavirus, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the aforesaid threat warrants and necessitates an extension of the State of Emergency within the Borough;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Borough Council of Hallam Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

1. The State of Emergency for Hallam Borough shall be extended for a period of 30 days until May 22, 2020.
2. Borough residents are encouraged to follow the direction of public health officials in curbing the spread of the COVID-19 virus and ensure the health and safety of our community members.
3. The Borough municipal building, located at 250 West Beaver Street, Hallam, shall not be open to the general public for the duration of the state of emergency.
4. Clayton Ely Emig Park, located at 2 Buttonwood Lane, Hallam, shall not be open to the general public for the duration of the state of emergency.
5. The Borough shall continue operations through telephone and electronic mail. All communications and questions for the Borough administration shall be made via telephone and electronic mail.

6. All payments and fees to be made to the Borough, including tax payments and permit fees, shall be handled through the secure drop box located in front of the Borough office at 250 West Beaver Street, Hallam.


