

REGULAR MEETING OF HALLAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

March 15, 2020

An emergency meeting of the Hallam Borough Council was held in the Borough Building at 5:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Glenn Wascovich, President William Fitzpatrick, Harry (Chip) Smith, Jr., Melody Stine, Matthew Flinchbaugh and Crystal Weston.

Sharon Dupler, Secretary, and Phil Smith were also present.

President Fitzpatrick stated Mayor Wascovich requested a meeting to discuss the current Coronavirus (COVID-19) global pandemic and the effect on the Hallam Borough community.

Mayor Wascovich declared a State of Emergency Proclamation that will go into effect at 8:00 a.m. on Monday, March 16, 2020 and will remain in effect for seven (7) days. He also issued a Public Statement in coordination with the State of Emergency Proclamation which ordered the Hallam Borough Municipal building and Emig Park be closed to the general public until the expiration of the proclamation or its extension, if needed.

Sharon will contact the Borough Solicitor to prepare a draft Resolution in case an extension is needed and also issue a SwiftReach call to residents informing them of the State of Emergency.

Chip moved, seconded by Crystal to adjourn at 6:00 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
