

## REGULAR MEETING OF HALLAM BOROUGH COUNCIL

October 22, 2020

The second monthly meeting of the Hallam Borough Council was held virtually using the GoToMeeting platform at 6:00 p.m. with the following members present: Mayor Glenn Wascovich, President Bill Fitzpatrick, VP Harry (Chip) Smith, Jr., Melody Stine, Matthew Flinchbaugh, Kim Krotzer, Cindy Knox and Crystal Weston.

Sharon Dupler, Secretary, Sherry Myers, Zoning Officer and Treasurer and to the best of my knowledge the following attendees: Chris Courogen (Lancaster Newspapers) and Joanie Griffith were also present.

Matthew moved, seconded by Crystal to approve the October 12<sup>th</sup> minutes. Yes-Bill, Kim, Crystal, Matthew, Melody, Cindy. Chip-Sharon could not hear or see vote. Motion passed.

President Fitzpatrick called for public comment. There was none.

There was discussion on the Proposed 2021 General Fund Budget figures.

There was some discussion on the Cherry Avenue bridge replacement project. Matthew moved, seconded by Chip to apply for a grant in 2021 and apply, with a cap amount, for a Pennsylvania Infrastructure Bank loan to cover the remaining cost. Matthew rescinded the motion. Council decided to table discussion on the Cherry Avenue bridge replacement until the November Council meeting. Sharon will contact Derek to confirm the replacement cost so Council can determine what amount should be considered for financing.

Any Council member that would like to voluntarily donate their compensation back to the Borough can do so by contacting Sherry. She will need something in writing to provide to the Auditors. Council decided to postpone redesigning the Borough's website until next year. There was discussion on a new copier for the Borough office. Kim moved, seconded by Matthew to purchase a new copier from Doceo in the amount of \$4,725.00. Motion passed unanimously.

Bill announced there will be an Executive Session held at 6:00 p.m. prior to the November 9, 2020 Council meeting to discuss employee compensation for the 2021 budget.

Chip moved, seconded by Cindy to adjourn at 7:47 p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
