ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1**

**AN ORDINANCE OF HALLAM BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
AMENDING CHAPTER 21, STREETS AND SIDEWALKS, PART 4, SECTION 403 OF
THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, SNOW, ICE AND OTHER MATERIAL ON
SIDEWALKS AND IN GUTTERS, RESPONSIBILITY FOR SNOW AND ICE
REMOVAL**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by Hallam Borough Council as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 21, Part 4, Section 403 of the Hallam Borough Code of Ordinances shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

The owner, occupant or tenant, as prescribed by Section 21-401 of every property fronting upon or alongside any street in the Borough, shall remove or cause to be removed from all sidewalks fronting and alongside the property, all snow and ice, within 24 hours after the snow or ice has ceased to fall or to be formed upon the sidewalk. It shall be unlawful for the owner, occupant or tenant of any property to remove snow or ice by placing it into the street. A violation of this section shall be subject to a fine or penalty as imposed under Section 21-405.

Section 2. Severability. If any subsection, sentence or clause of this ordinance is held, for any reason to be invalid, such decision or decisions shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 3. Repealer. All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.


Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall be effective immediately.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED into an Ordinance this 8th day of March, 2021 by the Council of the Borough of Hallam, in lawful session duly assembled.


