**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-4**

**AN ORDINANCE OF HALLAM BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,  
AMENDING AND RESTATING ORDINANCES 1978-03, 1997-02, 2004-01, 2009-01 AND  
2014-05, RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARKS AND RECREATION PLACES  
CODIFIED AS CHAPTER 16, PART 1 OF THE HALLAM BOROUGH CODE OF  
ORDINANCES**

---

**WHEREAS**, Hallam Borough Council has heretofore duly enacted ordinances regulating the conduct within and use of Clayton Eli Emig Park and other places of recreation.

**WHEREAS**, it is the desire of the Hallam Borough Council to further amend these those ordinances

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, AND IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND  
ORDAINED BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF HALLAM BOROUGH AS FOLLOWS:**

**Part 1  
RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARKS AND RECREATION PLACES**

**Section 1. Rules and Regulations Applicable in C.E. Emig Community Park.**

1. The use of the CE. Emig Community Park by the public shall be subject to the following rules and regulations that are adopted for the protection and safety of the public visiting and using those facilities as well as for the protection and safety of the property made available for public use by Hallam Borough:
  - A. The hours for this park shall be from dawn to dusk.
  - B. The pavilions may be reserved by contacting the Hallam Borough Office. There will be a charge for the use of a pavilion, which shall be established by a resolution of Hallam Borough Council from time to time.
  - C. No motorized vehicles (including motorcycles, mini bikes and snowmobiles) shall be allowed anywhere in the park except in the parking lot.

- D. Littering is prohibited. All trash shall be placed in trash receptacles.
- E. No bicycles or other wheeled personal devices shall be allowed in the pavilions. Devices used for mobility assistance by differently abled persons are exempt from this prohibition.
- F. There shall be no hanging from or climbing on pavilion rafters.
- G. No open fires shall be allowed, for any reason.
- H. No horses or other large farm animals shall be allowed in the park.
- I. There shall be no trapping, hunting, disturbing or harming in any way the wild life in Emig Park.
- J. Tent camping is not allowed, for any reason.
- K. No alcoholic beverages or drugs of any nature whatsoever allowed in Emig Park premises.
- L. It shall be unlawful to willfully deface or damage any building, seats, benches, equipment, trees, plants, shrubbery, grass, flowers or any other property pertaining to such park area or dig any holes or cut any sod.
- M. The park may be occupied for special events only by approval of Borough Council. The event organizer shall apply to Council in writing a minimum of 60 days prior to the event and shall include a description of the expected attendance and demonstrate to Council's satisfaction that there is adequate liability insurance, parking, rest room facilities and trash receptacles. The application should include a site plan with a traffic control plan, location of first aid/medical equipment and a list of vendors with all applicable vendor licensing/inspections. In addition Council may charge a security deposit and a rental fee, which shall be established from time to time as part of the Borough fee resolution.

**Section 2. Penalty.**

Any person who violates any provision of Section 1, after a hearing before a District Magistrate, shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$50 or more than \$1,000 for each offense.

**Section 3. Repealer.**


All prior ordinances that are inconsistent herewith are repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

This ordinance shall be effective immediately.




