Chapter 7

FIRE PREVENTION AND FIRE PROTECTION

Part 1

RECOGNITION OF VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY

§ 7-101. Fire Company Recognized. [Ord. 1990-1, 3/12/1990, § 1; as amended by Ord. 2004-1, 2/9/2004, § 1]

The Friendship Fire Company of Hallam organized and existing in the Borough of Hallam, York County, Pennsylvania, is hereby designated as the officially recognized fire company for the Borough of Hallam.

§ 7-102. Authorized Activities of the Fire Company. [Ord. 1990-1, 3/12/1990, § 2]

- 1. The fire company recognized by the Borough of Hallam is hereby authorized to provide such services to the citizens of the Borough of Hallam as may be necessary for the protection of property and persons situate therein which include, by way of example, and not of limitation, the extinguishment and prevention of loss of life and property from fire, automobile accidents, medical emergencies, hazardous materials incidents and other dangerous situations.
- 2. The company may also provide nonemergency and public service functions such as, again by way of example and not of limitation, removing water from property after storms and assisting in the removal, abatement and prevention of damage or injury to persons or property, whether through natural causes or man-made situations.
- 3. The company may also conduct and participate in such training activities and drills, either within or outside of the Borough of Hallam, as may be deemed necessary by the officers of the company to maintain proficiency in providing service.
- 4. The company may also respond to calls for assistance or to provide mutual-aide outside of the Borough of Hallam.

§ 7-103. Authorized Activities of Members of the Fire Company. [Ord. 1990-1, 3/ 12/1990, § 3]

- 1. In addition to actually participating in the activities of the fire company as authorized above, or in going to or returning from any activity, the members of the fire company recognized by the Borough of Hallam are also authorized to do the following:
 - A. Engage in any type of drill, training, ceremony, practice, test or parade when duly called for or authorized by an officer or officers of the fire company.
 - B. Engage in fund-raising activities for the fire company, when authorized by an officer or officers of the fire company.
 - C. Engage in the performance of any other duty or activity authorized by any officer of the recognized fire company.
